1. Certificate in Pharmacy (2 years)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- a. Candidates should be between 16-45 Years of age by the date of application.
- b. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with three credits in English plus two of the following science subjects namely Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science or Chemistry
- 2. Certificate in Community Midwifery (18 Months)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- a. Candidates should be females between 20-50 Years of age by the date of application
- b. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with pass in either **Biology** or **Physical science**
- 3. Diploma in Nursing and midwifery (3 Years)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

a. Candidates should be between 16-45 Years of age by the date of application

 b. Candidates should posses a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with four credits in English, Biology and Physical Science or physics or chemistry plus one of the following science subjects Mathematics, Agriculture, Home Economics, General Science or Geography

NOTE: If Mathematics is not a credit, it should at least be a strong pass of seven points (7)

4. Diploma in Clinical Medicine (3 years)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Candidates should be between 17-45 Years of age by the date of application.
- 2. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six credits in English, Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science or physics and chemistry plus any two subjects

Applicants meeting the above requirements should deposit K10,000 non-refundable registration fees to National Bank of Malawi before 17th December, 2021 and download application form on college website: www.ecohs.ac.mw or collect the form from the campus.
